

As Macron champions Europe, a nationalist school opens in France

ACROSS THE CONTINENT, from Finland to Portugal, Emmanuel Macron is leading the charge against Europe's nationalists. He might want to look closer to home.

In western France, Marion Marechal has ambitions to train the next generation of anti-establishment, anti-European French leaders. From September, Marechal is starting her own graduate school, where she'll seek to shape the politicians of the future to help spread her vision. "We need to



win back the influence and the elite in France and our youth — those who have a vision, roots and are patriotic — have to work to succeed and engage in the national debate," Marechal, 28, said in an interview.

Until a few months ago, Marechal went by the name Marechal-Le Pen. The granddaughter of National Front founder Jean-Marie Le Pen, she's been touted as a rising star of the right. She spoke at the US Conservative Political Action Conference in Maryland in March, and has been praised as "one of the most impressive people in the entire world" by former Donald Trump adviser Steve Bannon.

She dropped the Le Pen and put her political career on hold after her aunt Marine Le Pen lost to Macron last year, Marine Le Pen's second failure in a pres-

idential election.

As Marechal seeks a new means of influencing the debate, Macron — the 40-year-old poster child of liberal Europe — is railing against her nationalist peers. In recent months he has taken his pro-EU message to Denmark, Finland, Spain and Portugal as he campaigns for May elections to the European Parliament.

"I won't retreat in front of the nationalists and those preaching hatred," Macron said in Copenhagen on Wednesday. "If they want to see me as their main opponent, they're right."

#MeToo complaints strain human rights agencies

AWAVE OF sexual harassment complaints that accompanied the (hash)MeToo movement is straining many of the state and local offices tasked with policing workplace discrimination of all kinds.

Places such as New York City and Massachusetts have added resources to deal with the surge in complaints, but human rights agencies elsewhere say their small staffs are struggling to keep up with growing case loads.

In Connecticut, which is on pace to receive nearly twice as many sexual harassment complaints as last year, some lawmakers worry about delays resolving those cases and others involving employment, housing and credit discrimination.

"If someone has gotten up the strength to come forward, I don't want that strength to be dissipated because of a system that's broken," state Senator Mae Flexer said.

Flexer, a Democrat, pushed unsuccessful legislation this year that would have given the state Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities funding to help fill empty positions, extended the deadline for victims to file complaints and required more companies to provide sexual harassment training.

Connecticut had 158 sexual harassment complaints filed all of last year. Over the first six months of 2018, the commis-

sion received 131, records show. An agency spokeswoman, Michelle Dumas Koller, said that the uptick has not gotten to an "onerous level" yet, and that the staff is working hard to get cases out between a year and a year and a half. But she acknowledges there's been "a significant decline of staff" over the past decade. As in many places, the complaints are being piled up last year, when the movement against sexual harassment and assault took off after allegations against former Hollywood mogul Harvey Weinstein.

The state offices that enforce laws concerning various types of discrimination differ in their authority and scope of responsibility. For example, Connecticut's human rights referees can award back pay and damages for emotional distress and attorneys' fees to those employees who choose to use the system. In many states, complainants are required to file first with these agencies, even if they eventually bring their case to court — a process that can take years. Numerous cities and counties also have commissions on civil rights, human rights and fair housing.

Kavanaugh pledges to be 'team player' on Supreme Court

SUPREME COURT NOMINEE Brett Kavanaugh promised on Tuesday to be a "team player" if confirmed to the closely divided court, declaring that he will be a "pro-law judge" who won't decide cases based on his personal views. With Republicans hoping to move the Supreme Court to the right for years to come, President Donald Trump's nominee, who has a solidly conservative record, declared he would be even-handed in his approach to the law.

"A good judge must be an umpire — a neutral and impartial arbiter who favours no litigant or policy," Kavanaugh said in prepared opening remarks. "I'm not a pro-plaintiff or pro-defendant judge. I am not a pro-prosecution or pro-defense judge." "I would always strive to be a team player on the Team of Nine," he added.

The Supreme Court is more often thought of as nine separate law firms, rather than a team. And on the most contentious cases, the court tends to split into two teams, conservative and liberal. But the justices often say they seek consensus when they can, and they like to focus on how frequently they reach unanimous decisions.

Kavanaugh, 53, has served for the past 12 years on the appeals court in Washington, D.C., which is considered the second most important court in the country after the Supreme Court. His conservative record includes a dissenting opinion last year that would have denied immediate access to an abortion for an immigrant teenager in federal custody.

AI camera may help robotic vehicles detect obstacles faster

STANFORD SCIENTISTS HAVE developed an artificial intelligence (AI) camera that can recognise objects faster, and could be used to help autonomous vehicles better navigate through obstacles.

The image recognition technology that underlies au-

tonomous cars and aerial drones depends on AI. The computers teach themselves to recognise objects like a dog, a pedestrian crossing the street or a stopped car. The problem is that the computers running the AI algorithms are currently too large and slow for future applications like hand-held medical devices. The researchers from Stanford Uni-

versity in the US combined two types of computers to create a faster and less energy-intensive image processor.
